

Business Minor for CS Majors

The Business minor requires 42 credit hours. Students applying for a Business minor must have a minimum 2.0 GPA in at least 24 prior semester hours, have completed MATH 1525-26 or its equivalent (1205-06, 1114) and have a C- or higher in all previous ACIS, BIT, ECON, FIN, MGT, and MKTG courses taken.

Upper division business courses require prior completion of 60 hours, with a minimum 2.0 overall GPA; completion of MATH 1525-6, ACIS 1504, ACIS 2115-6, BIT 2405-6, and ECON 2005-6, (or equivalent courses), with a minimum combined GPA of 2.0 for these nine courses, and have no more than one D in each of the four departments, (ACIS, BIT, ECON, MATH).
